Encourage cross-border teacher exchange programs for diverse perspectives.




OBJECTIVES

 exchange, and build a sense of community.
- Create and validate a European digital platform for teachers in transition, integrating an international Learning Community to share resources and insights.
- Promote widespread adoption of the digital platform within educational institutions, validating its effectiveness and fostering collaboration among educators across borders.
- Implement psychosocial support initiatives, including workshops and counseling, to address burnout and stress-related issues, enhancing
 job satisfaction and mental well-being.
- Foster ongoing collaboration among EU member countries to share best practices and strategies in teacher training, creating a collective knowledge base for continuous improvement.

RESULTS

- Define and validate a European model for teacher training from student to active teacher.
- Development and validation of a European digital platform for teachers in transition.
- An international and intercultural Learning Community is being developed to support and improve teaching practices.
- A European Social Network is being developed to improve the transition between initial training and induction into the school workforce.



CONCLUSIONS

The feedback on improving university training for teachers highlights four key conclusions:

- Practical Classes: Emphasize practical classes early on to prepare teachers for diverse student groups and effective parent engagement.
- Specialized Training in Modern Tools: Incorporate specialized training on speed reading, internet resources, and AI in education to keep educators updated.
- Motivational Strategies: Prioritize strategies to boost motivation among future educators.
- Organizational Integration: Include aspects of school organizational affairs in training to better prepare teachers for the complexities of their roles.

These findings underscore the importance of a comprehensive and dynamic approach to teacher training that addresses practical skills, modern tools, motivation, and organizational aspects.
